- The provision of information, advice and support to target groups and families.
 Information concerning the range of services and development options available locally and advice on accessing rights and entitlements.
- Delivery of education courses and training opportunities in collaboration with Mayo
 Sligo and Leitrim Education and Training Board.
- The establishment and maintenance of new community groups to meet local needs and the delivery of services at local level (for example, childcare facilities, after-school clubs, men's groups, etc.)
- The provision of counselling and support to individuals of the community and catchment areas.
- The provision of universal supports to individuals and groups.
- Developing capacity and leadership within community and catchment areas that Mohill Family Support Centre CLG support.
- Supporting personal and group development.
- Practical assistance to individuals and community groups such as access to information technology and office facilities.
- Practical assistance to existing community groups such as help with organisational structures, assistance with accessing funding or advice on how to address specific social issues.
